<sup>\*</sup>No course may be applied to more than one breadth requirement with the exceptions of the course taken to meet the Ethnicity requirement and the course taken to meet the ENGL 001C/Writing Across the Curriculum (WAC) requirement. Ethnic Studies courses may be used to fulfill EITHER an additional social science OR additional humanities based on course content. WAC courses may fulfill the ENGL 001C requirement as well as the normal area of breadth that the non-WAC version of the course would fulfill. See *General Catalog*.
