The program leading to the Bachelor of Arts in Latin American Studies features study of the anthropology, economics, geography, history, sociology, languages, and cultures of the region for students to gain a broad understanding of a complex world area. The major provides great flexibility to explore a wide range of subjects of particular interest, from religious cults in the Caribbean to indigenous video in the Andes or the dynamics of agrarian reform in rural Mexico.

Lower-division requirements (5 units)

- a) LNST 001: Introduction to Latin American Studies
- b) Proficiency in Spanish to the SPN 005 level or in Portuguese to a comparable level

Note: *Additional course work in Spanish and/or Portuguese recommended for students interested in careers in Latin American fields.*
