<b>HISTORY MINOR COURSEWORK (28 units/7 courses)</b>			
Students must maintain 2.0 major, quarter and cumulative GPA's in order to remain in good academic standing.

UPPER DIVISION REQUIREMENTS (20 units/5 courses)
